

ILLNESS Please keep your child home with the following symptoms:

1. Fever
2. Severe cold
3. Diarrhea
4. Vomiting
5. Rash, undiagnosed
6. Oozing eyes, sore throat

We reserve the right to close classrooms or entire center due to Covid positive case or cases.

NOTIFIABLE ILLNESSES: *Please alert center and notice will be posted.* COVID, Pinkeye, Aids, Chicken Pox, Hepatitis A, B &C, Herpes, Measles, Mumps, Pertussis, Ringworm, Head Lice. We reserve the right to check your child for lice and send them home until infestation is gone.

FOR LIABILITY PURPOSES, WE WILL NOT ADMINISTER MEDICATION OR BREATHING TREATMENTS. With a signed permission slip, we will apply diaper cream, sunscreen, and teething gel. An Epee-Pen can be kept on hand for your child. Kid's Kountry encourages parents to screen their children for dental, vision, hearing, and health. Up to date shot records must be on file.

EMERGENCIES: In case of medical emergency, parent will be notified immediately. If it is life threatening, and we cannot reach parent, an ambulance will be called. As a courtesy, we will send a teacher in a separate vehicle, when possible.

EVACUATION: In case of an outside threat, staff and children will walk or ride to the nearest public school or to a public grocery store. If rides are needed, transportation will be in all available vans and staff cars.

We will be closed the entire week of Christmas Eve to New Year's Day, Good Friday, Thanksgiving/the day after, July 4th, Labor & Memorial Day, Good Friday.

MISSING CHILD: In the rare case that a child is missing from the center, we will first search the center, if perhaps they have wandered to another room, then the outside premises, next the police and parents will be notified immediately. Licensing will be notified by a phone call and written report.

On a **FIELD TRIP**, we check the list of children leaving the center, exiting the vans, gathering, and participating, reentering the vans and upon arrival back at the center. If a child intentionally runs away from us they will be subject to suspension from the center. We have the right to restrict a misbehaving child from participation in field trips if we deem it necessary.

FIRE DRILLS are practiced monthly at Kid's Kountry and the Las Cruces Fire Department inspects the facility annually. Fire extinguishers are serviced annually as well as emergency lighting and exit signs.

LATE PICK UPS: You will be charged \$50. for every fifteen minutes that you are late in picking up your children after 6:00 pm. If you have not called, after 30 minutes, we will contact CPS or the police to pick up your children.

PLEASE BRING AN EXTRA SET OF CLOTHES: By signing, you are giving us permission to change the clothing of your child in case of an accident. We may wash and dry and can usually clean the original clothing and replace them that same day.

SCHOOL AGE PARENTS must notify us if their child is absent from school so that our van drivers know not to pick

them up, so parent, school and day care all know who has the child.

We follow the public schools schedule for closures. Check LCPS site.

PICK UP AND DROP OFF RULES:

1. Clock in and out daily
2. Take child to classroom
3. Make sure you are acknowledged by the teacher at pick up/ drop off.
4. **Once you arrive to pick up your children, we are not responsible if you let your children go out the front door without you. If this happens, your services will be suspended for a day. You may be terminated if it happens again.**
5. If your school age child is sick or suspended from school, they may not attend Kid's Kountry.

REASONS YOUR CHILDCARE CAN BE TERMINATED: If you are disrespectful to staff. If you do not pay your bill on time, and/or When the teacher must spend a disproportionate amount of time with a disabled or behaviorally challenged child, thus taking attention away from the other kids.

THESE STEPS WILL BE TAKEN:

1. Teacher or director will document child's behavior, or child's effect on the class.
2. Parent will meet with staff to make a plan of action.
3. If situation does not improve, at the discretion of Kid's Kountry, the child may be terminated. I agree to abide by these policies:
